Job Description: Peace Patrol (3 people-1 per night)

To provide roving security throughout the social. Also will help the ushers at door if short.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Patrol specific areas in each dance area, plus spend time at the coat check or usher as needed
- Conflict resolution
- Provide public safety by protecting people and property, and promoting good community relations
- Encourage people to move along after late night performances have completed
- Call for the event manager if there is a situation you are uncomfortable handling
- Overall, maintain a happy, healthy and safe environment for everyone
- Provide first aid or notify first aid workers if the situation arises

Skills Required:

- Friendly and courteous attitude
- Being aware of surroundings and people
- Capable of following instructions and can work well independently or in a group
- Good judgement, decision making and problem solving skills
- Confident
- Knows how to use a Naxolone kit if necessary
- Great people and communication skills
- Experience is an asset
- First Aid Certification is an asset
- Demonstrate an ability to connect with people
- Understand and complies with the Canada International Dance Convention volunteer regulations and code of ethics

Commitment:

- The shifts are 4-hours, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday
- Shifts are 10pm-2am
- Expectations is that you will be able to work more within those days
- Required to attend 1 volunteer session on October 13 (afternoon) in Guelph or October 30 in Toronto (evening)
